MEDGuard Project in the European Maritime Day

Throughout last week from 16th to the 20th of May, on the occasion of the celebration of the European Maritime Day, took place a variety of activities on board of the fishing vessel “Ciudad de Cartagena”, which has been reassigned into a school-ship.

Tens of citizens took part in the touristic activities in the coast of Cartagena in which they had the chance to get to know better the fishing tradition of the area and its fishing arts. Also they participated in a sailing knots workshop, in a visit to the fish farms and they had the opportunity to see/sight different species of dolphins.

At the end of the activities, all participants took a survey which provided valuable information in order to carry out an analysis on the viability of the diversification of these vessels and their crews into alternative activities other than fishing.

During the Closing Ceremony of European Maritime Day, the vessel and MEDGuard project was presented to all the personalities of the sector that attended the event, whom took part in a guided boat tour.
